



## BYO Chromebook Program 2026

Kingston Heath Primary School operates a **Bring Your Own Chromebook Device (BYOD)** program for students in Years 3-6 to support engaging and personalised learning across the curriculum. The program allows students to bring an approved Chromebook device to school each day to use as a learning tool.

BYOD enables students to access online learning platforms, collaborate with peers, and develop essential digital skills in a safe and supported environment. Devices are used to enhance—not replace—hands-on, creative, and collaborative learning experiences.

Clear guidelines ensure that devices are used responsibly and that all students have equitable access to digital learning opportunities. Outlined below is more detailed information about purchase options, device specifications, insurance and setup support.

Together, we're preparing our students to be confident, capable, and responsible digital citizens.

To support families, our school is working in partnership with **Learning with Technologies (LWT)** to provide access to **high-quality devices at competitive education pricing**. This partnership ensures families can purchase reliable, school-approved devices with warranty and service options, giving peace of mind and value for money.

### To order your child a Chromebook device through LWT:

1. Go to the website [Kingston Heath Primary School Order Portal - LWT](#)
2. Select your device and continue.
3. Laptop bag/case. It will be compulsory for the device to have a protective case. Please purchase this if you do not have another option.
4. Select other accessories if needed.
5. Finalise purchase.

Our school has chosen to use **Chromebooks as the only supported device** because they integrate seamlessly with our Department of Education systems and software licences. This ensures consistency, ease of use, and the ability for our teachers and technical staff to provide full classroom and network support. Chromebooks purchased through other suppliers are welcome; however, they must meet school specifications and include **insurance coverage**, as the school cannot take responsibility for loss or damage. **Chromebooks purchased through LWT are inclusive of 3 year onsite warranty which covers impact damage and liquid spills.**

Please note that the school technician is **unable to connect non-Chromebook devices** to the school network or provide technical assistance for unsupported models.

**Please note that our school does not have insurance to cover accidental damage to students' devices, and parents/carers are encouraged to consider obtaining their own insurance for their child's device.**
